Workshop Pre-requisites

Laptop, or a desktop computer you can carry in.
Power is available at each desk.

Scanner – flatbed with film capability, **or** a dedicated film scanner, plus a flatbed scanner.
Basic understanding of your scanning software recommended.

Images – in a camera or phone and able to connect to your computer (or use those you can access on the computer). Plus any negatives, slides or photographs you want to scan.

Copy of Lightroom - If you download a trial version, make sure it will still be active for a few days after the workshop. Strongly suggest downloading and activating only **one or two** days before 4 June (Course 705), if using a trial download.

Good to know

You will be working on your own images, with everyone doing each step together before moving onto the next step. Time will be given for everyone to follow the steps, and those more experienced can help others. The aim is to give you confidence and be inspired to continue scanning and editing well after the workshop ends.
