

COVID-19 Announcement #5

13 October 2021.

In line with the ACT Government's easing of COVID restrictions on 15 October 2021, the Family History ACT (FHA)CT) premises at the Cook Community Hub will re-open as of Tuesday 19 October 2021.

The new regulations require facemasks to be worn at all times and caps the number of people to one per every 4 square meters. Our main Library is capped at a maximum of 20, while the Education Room and Overseas Rooms are capped at a maximum of 10 people. All attendees must check in with the Check-in Canberra App.

Some SIG, SUG and MSG Convenors may choose to return to face to face or hybrid meetings, but in-person numbers will be limited. Please check with your convenor and ensure you book a ticket via the website.
