

COVID Announcement – Number 6 – November 2021

In line with the ACT Government's easing of COVID restrictions on 12 November 2021, the wearing of facemasks in the FHACT Library and Education Room is optional.

Wearing a face mask is a simple and practical way to minimise transmission of the virus. FHACT encourages members to continue wearing face masks indoors in crowded settings or when where physical distancing from people not known to them may not be possible.

All attendees must check-in with the Check-in Canberra App.

The room density requirements have also been relaxed slightly. Our main Library is capped at a maximum of 20, while Overseas Rooms is capped at a maximum of 10 people and the Education Room at 18 people.

Numbers for in-person and hybrid meetings are limited. Please check with your convenor and ensure you book a ticket via the website, before attending.
