Core restrictions across all settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • COVID-19 Safety Plans must be prepared and be able to be produced if requested by an authorised officer. • The use of the Check in CBR app is optional.
Face coverings/masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facemasks are no longer required to be worn, but members are encouraged to wear them if they are in a crowded environment. • A person is not required to wear a face mask if they have a physical or mental health illness or condition, or disability, which makes wearing a face mask detrimental to their condition.
Community and Cultural Facilities, Activities and Attractions	<p>Libraries</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No density limits or special restrictions. <p>Community Centres, Facilities or Youth Centres</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No density limits or special restrictions.
